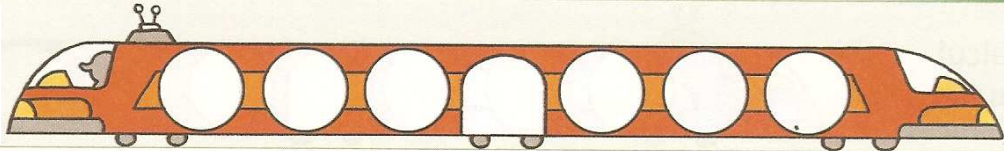

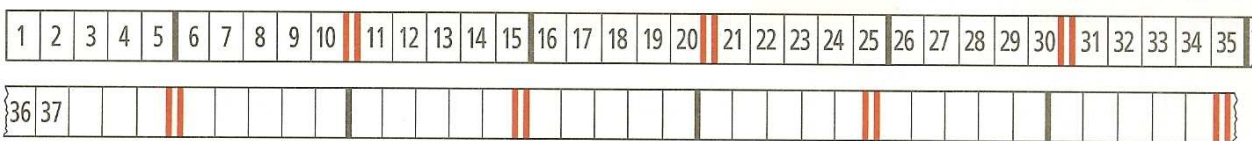

A. Quick mental arithmetic: same activity as on page 75.

B. This 'dictionary of numbers' is a part of the list of numbers: horizontally the one and same number is written in four different ways; vertically, we deal with a normal number sequence with the usual landmarks 10, 15 and 20. As for the numbers in full after 10, the cases of 11 and 12 should be discussed. It must be emphasized that even though we cannot hear the suffix '-teen' meaning 'ten' in these two numbers, whereas for all the following numbers up to 20, we do hear it, it doesn't mean that it isn't present because it is represented in the forms $10+1$ and $10+2$ and it is also written in the first digits of 11 and 12.
